The Newfoundland and Labrador Stuttering Association (NLSA), established in 2018, is a small volunteer-driven, not-for-profit organization that promotes awareness, education, understanding and acceptance of stuttering. This event is The NLSA's main source of revenue. The NLSA does not receive any government funding.

Proceeds from this event supports The NLSA Bursary Program, established in 2018, which helps subsidize specialized treatment and equipment for people who stutter, others with communication disorders and their families with financial needs, to help ensure that they are not denied treatment due to their ability to pay. **Since 2018, The NLSA has awarded \$6,000.00 in Bursaries.**

Proceeds from this event also helps support our community outreach programs and services such as our monthly people who stutter and family Support Group, our annual "FINDING OUR VOICE" Conference, fund public awareness and educational campaigns, and allow expansion of our community engagement and advocacy initiatives throughout the province.
